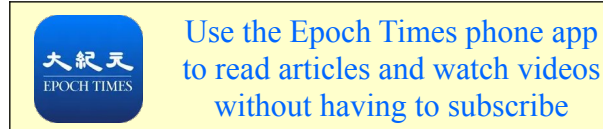

- “ABC News: Sydney has longest spell of days below 30 degrees Celsius in 140 years”  
*“While the weather has definitely at least resembled a version of summer since the pre-Christmas record cold spell, Tuesday's maximum of 26.6 degrees at Observatory Hill marked the 323<sup>rd</sup> consecutive day under 30°C, already the longest stretch in three decades. Sydney's maximums are forecast to remain below 30 through the remainder of this week, extending the run of sub-30°C days to at least 327, the most since the record of 339 days from 1883.”*

- “Fuel Costs of Electric Vehicles Overtake Gas-Powered Cars: Study”  
*“The cost to fuel electric vehicles (EV) in the United States is higher than the cost to fuel gas-powered cars for the first time in 18 months, a consulting company said. In Q4 2022, typical mid-priced ICE [Internal Combustion Engine] car drivers paid about \$11.29 to fuel their vehicles for 100 miles of driving. That cost was around \$0.31 cheaper than the amount paid by mid-priced EV drivers charging mostly at home, and over \$3 less than the cost borne by comparable EV drivers charging commercially,” Anderson Economic Group (AEG) said in an analysis.”*

- “20-minute neighbourhoods” (Melbourne, Australia)  
*“Plan Melbourne 2017–2050 is the Victorian Government’s long-term planning strategy, guiding the way the city will grow and change to 2050. Plan Melbourne is supported by the principle of 20-minute neighbourhoods. The 20-minute neighbourhood is all about ‘living locally’. It allows people to meet most of their daily needs within a 20-minute return walk from home, with access to safe cycling and local transport options. These connected and walkable places are where people can live, work and play; buy their bread and milk, work from home or at a local business, access services and meet their neighbours at community gathering places. Plan Melbourne aims to make the 20-minute neighbourhood concept a reality for every person.”*
