Complacency is a killer of progression. When we're content to be where we are, we don't want any changes made to our *status quo*. This is an inertial trait that's common to everyone, except the go-getters who can't stay 'tied down'.

The Kingdom is advancing in this New Era¹, so we must move with it. The speed of changes will increase as more and more sons align with the plans of Heaven. I remember being told years ago² through my prophetic journal that the following year would be even busier than the previous one. This has been the situation ever since because I decided to align my will with Father's business. For example: Last year I was told to do a diploma course which took up considerable time, and this year I've been told to do the follow-on advanced diploma course. Busy, busy, busy – all on Kingdom business.

The world around us is changing at a rapid pace as well, so we can't be wanting things to settle down or wanting to 'live in the past'. All this change means the world <u>and</u> the Kingdom are both in a state of dynamic flux. Therefore, we need to condition ourselves to cope with both. If we don't, we'll find ourselves shutting down and living a more isolated existence. Which, of course, would take us out of the sphere of impacting others with the Kingdom.

Advice to advance with the changes comes from Heaven, as well as from observation:

"Nothing is really ever static. Change is ongoing and inevitable. So when everything seems to be unfamiliar and foreign do not resist. Set your heart and mind to move with the flow of transition. Instead of clinging to the past with stubborn refusal to advance, your best course of action is to adjust your attitude and to embrace the newness of what life has to offer you."³

Remember, our process of maturing as sons requires a great deal of change. We'd better start desiring change so we can grow and develop in our sonship.
