

# Dealing with ‘Bad’ Days

‘Bad’ days throw us off kilter and cause us to operate outside of our sonship. That is, unless we’re careful to be proactive during the day, as a son should.

From my observation and experience, most of us allow the day to get ‘on top of’ us and then look for comfort to ease the pain. That’s not the Kingdom way.

I could tell you all the ways I handle ‘bad’ days, but rather than bore you, I won’t. Rather than give you some teaching on how to handle them properly, and have you ignore it, I’ll let our King tell you himself.

*“Heavenly life is my portion that I share with you today. Have I not seated you in heavenly places and enthroned you at my right hand as an overcomer? All the blessings of heaven I give to you. Receive more, for there are always greater treasures of revelation. Drink of the water of life, which flows from before my throne. It is my joy to bestow upon you every blessing, paid for with my blood.*

*This heavenly life doesn’t mean you will never face trials. It doesn’t mean that you won’t ever have a bad day. As a matter of fact, your enemy hates you because you are mine. What it does mean is that during trials, you’ll have a place of refuge. When you’re having a bad day, you’ll know how to tap into my grace. When the enemy rears his ugly head, you have a fountain of joy that makes him mad. For every opposition, you will taste victory. Heaven’s gift is yours, this very day. The gift of my Spirit is within you—the gift of an overcomer.”<sup>1</sup>*

All we need to do is practise this and we’ll see the benefits. We’ll still have ‘bad’ days, but they won’t up-tip us.

When we do ‘bomb out’ and don’t have victory, our King is still there to support us:

*“Allow Me to heal your heartache for all the losses you have endured. Know that you are not alone and that I am with you to bring comfort and to show you the way to the fulfillment of My desire and plan for your life. Do not despair. Look to Me for wisdom and direction.”<sup>2</sup>*

Notice that he doesn’t judge us and find us guilty of failure? He understands our failures, and as we are ‘sinless’<sup>3</sup>, he can work on encouraging us and drawing us in to be changed so we can deal with ‘bad’ days.
