

Doing Our Part to Fulfil Our Purpose and Achieve Our Destiny

Many look to prophets to guide them into their future and into their destiny. That's not how we, as sons, are expected to move forward in our lives.

Sonship is all about intimacy and oneness with the Trinity – that's their greatest delight. As part of our relationship with them, they supply us with all the knowledge we need to live our lives which comes through their personal spiritual communication with us. That's the way Adam and Ezer¹ functioned, and it's also how Jesus of Nazareth did, as well. That means that Spirit-to-spirit communication is vital for everyday living, as well as for our future. It's just as important as being Spirit-led in the moment.

For myself, one of the important things that I do is to extract knowledge from the personal messages I receive from father.² I do that to ensure that what I'm given doesn't dissipate from my mind, but stays there for me to use in my decision-making. That way, what I learn from them augments what I know in my spirit from the original download. It always helps to remember what the Trinity has said to me because they don't say things 'for the sake of saying them'.

With all that in mind, here's an interesting message from Father recently:

*"Like bees in a hive, you are not alone. It takes every bee doing its part to produce honey. You already know what you need to do to coexist with others. You must do your part to fulfill your purpose and achieve your destiny."*³

Notice that we are required to do our part to fulfil our Kingdom purpose, so we can enter Father's destiny for us. Being nonchalant or laissez-faire in the way we live our lives is not being Spirit-led, and it's as dangerous as doing everything our way, without consulting Heaven.

Notice also that sonship is not totally about being Spirit-led, on a moment-by-moment basis, but it's also living by what we know. We have to do our part from what we've learnt from Father, and then the Spirit adds to that by providing his guidance. That's why being reprogrammed, so we have a renewed mind, is so critical for us to operate out of the right kind of knowledge – the Trinity's knowledge.

To confirm that, Father recently told me that sons have the prerogative to operate out of their experience and out of what they know.⁴ However, he said that he has to release them to operate like that. He will only release them when he determines that they're mature enough to function properly that way.

Here's an example of how that plays out: We choose our friends and acquaintances based on Heaven's wisdom and our personal experience. We don't have to wait for the Spirit to identify them for us.

*"Do not feel guilty for separating yourself from people who are not good for you. Set your heart to choose your relationships wisely so that there is mutual benefit with those who are close to you. And remember that you are called to always be kind to one another, tender-hearted and forgiving."*⁵

However, as we're listening to Holy Spirit all of the time, he'll guide us in such decisions – if he needs to.
