Father Wants Us to Change What We Believe

Unfortunately, religion and legalism keep us trapped in a set of beliefs and doctrines that we can't break free from. To break free requires revelation from the Spirit, <u>but</u> we need to be open for to receive revelation. We also need to give him permission to impart the revelation that's required. Our best tack is to <u>ask</u> to be changed and to ask for revelation that will change us. Only then can we break free and come to true knowledge – that is, the knowledge of the Trinity.
