## Formulating the Next Phase of Your Existence

Father has been teaching and training us over the past few year about make decisions for ourselves as we partner with him.<sup>1</sup> This revelation originally caused some degree of concern as we had initially come from the religious system where we made all our own decisions, and only wanted his intervention when we were 'stuck'. Following then period, we moved to the Pentecostal and Charismatic systems, where we were retrained to <u>only do what the Spirit directed us to do</u> (or say or go). Therefore, to be retrained by Father into a middle ground between the two of these positions, was a different paradigm, one which we are still coming to grips with.<sup>2</sup>

Here's a recent instruction in the form of a Spirit-inspired message, rather than a prophetic download, which relates to the decisions we make about our progression into the future:

"You are beginning to formulate the next phase of your existence, but you must not be hasty in carrying out the first blueprint of your plan. Take your time and make sure that what you are thinking about is prudent and in the best interest of everyone involved. This is a time when you need wisdom the most."

Notice that Father has <u>not</u> told us to only do the things that he says, but that we are to make decisions for ourselves – even plans for ourselves. Included in his message is the need for wisdom and prudence<sup>4</sup>, which means we draw what we need from him (i.e. wisdom, knowledge, understanding & discernment) and implement plans carefully.

There's a fine line to walk as sons as we learn to fulfil our role as his imagers and function out of authority as planet-managers, an advanced role that we're being trained to function in.
