

How Much We Succeed for the Kingdom Rests with Us

Working in the Kingdom is a partnership with the King¹ to implement Father's plans through the input of Holy Spirit. That's Kingdom '101' for sonship. (Just in case there are readers who are new to Heaven's concept of the Kingdom.)

Our King has schooled us that the partnership we have together – which is more like an apprenticeship – must be founded on our intimacy and oneness with him. From our side of the team, we're responsible to be in alignment with him, as much as it's possible. That requires us to develop the same heart and mind as his, through our oneness together, so we heartily approve of his plans in every area, whatever they may be. In that way we don't work against him. As logical as that sounds, we must remember that if we don't work with him, we actually work against him.

So, how does he want us to approach each day from the start, so we align with him from the moment we wake up?

The reason that's very important is because every human being has the autonomy to make their own decisions. We were created to operate that way, and it hasn't changed, even now we are sons. It's actually more critical for us because we've been reinstated to the position of the King's vice-regents to manage the planet and the natural order. Now, you may not agree with that, or even understand it, but that's the Kingdom reality we live in.

The imperative with that is that we're not slaves or servants of the King, as religion teaches. Instead, as sons, we are servants to humanity, just as Jesus of Nazareth demonstrated. Therefore, sons are required to live their lives, make personal decisions and take responsibility for them. We're not automatons² controlled by Holy Spirit – that would effectively remove us out of relationship as sons.

Continuing to make personal decisions in the same way we did before coming into the Kingdom has a big difference, in that Holy Spirit is always ready to download to us what's required to make those decisions. When he doesn't speak to our spirit, we need to still make appropriate decisions, full of confidence that whatever the outcome is, Father can handle it for us.

Here's his wisdom on this which he gave to us recently:

*“You can make your plans for the days ahead, but you must hold them loosely with an open hand because you do not know exactly what the future holds for you. Focus instead on maintaining honest and unfailing relationship with Me,” says the Lord. “And, trust that I will reveal all that you need to know when it is time. **Do your best with where you are and what you know about today.**”³*

*“Today is a new day, so begin your day with a positive attitude, **knowing that you can do all that I have called and chosen for you to do.** Be done with self-doubt and discouragement. Rise up out of the dead ashes of the past with confidence that I am with you to guide you and give you the wisdom and help that you need to succeed,” says the Lord.*⁴

*“**Making adjustments to accommodate current conditions is a must. Be flexible** and trust Me to direct your steps,” says the Lord. “Dire circumstances often require drastic measures. Do not be afraid to do whatever is necessary to get through difficult times. I am with you.”⁵*
