

How To Plan For Your Day

If you're planning to live your life like Jesus of Nazareth, who only did what Father told him or showed him, then you're in for a rough ride. Been there, done that.

There's a process involved to be able to operate like him. Firstly, you have to learn to hear with your spirit 24/7 and hear with absolute clarity. That, unfortunately, takes years of practise. It's not a skill you pick instantaneously, unless you have an encounter with the King and it's imparted to you. Normally, it's a process of trial-&-error until you get there. The usual stumbling blocks to success are the busyness of life, the distractions of life, and finding the time to sit and practise. The process involved in this means you'll make lots of mistakes because you're not hearing clearly. You'll also have problems as the enemy works against you gaining prowess in something that's averse to him.

Secondly, you need to be in deep oneness with the Trinity. This also takes a number of years because the transition to intimacy comes first and then a difficult process is required to fit you into oneness. I say "difficult" because the process for me required me to go through 'The Valley'¹ of testing for quite a while.

Thirdly, you need to fellowship with the Trinity by spending physical time and spiritual time hanging out in each others' company. The 'desert fathers'² were able to do this by living a monastic, isolated life style. For Jesus, and for us, that's not an option, because our task is to impact people, which we can't do when we're removed from them.

So, how do we live in the meantime, before we can live like Jesus did? Here's what Father has to say:

*"Do not project out to imagine what you will have to deal with in the days ahead. It is enough to take care of your responsibilities and needs of today. Hold your plans loosely with an open hand so that you can embrace change as it comes. Put your faith and trust in Me to direct your steps."*³

Take that on board.

The key is to let Father order your day. Allow him to oversee your life and to let the days progress under his ordering. As situations and circumstances change, check with your spirit to see what he wants you to do, say or where to go.

Father provided this advice on hearing:

*"Hear My word for it is true. If you will embrace the process of clearing the clutter from your mind, you will indeed hear Me. You will see the things that I have desired to show you. You will know of the things that I want to do for you and with you. This process is for each and every one of My children. Only believe what I am saying and set yourself to receive."*⁴

On top of that: Trust him to supply all your needs, because you're focused primarily on his Kingdom; listen with your spirit to his communications; ask his advice; ask him for wisdom, knowledge, understanding and discernment in your operations; be sensitive to inspirations (they don't all come from the natural realm); and fulfil your daily responsibilities at a level of excellence.

Learn to implicitly trust Father and rest in that trust. Then switch off your mind, your anxiousness, your worry, etc., and relax. Let him do what you can't do, because he's a doting Father who always 'has our back'.
