

# "I'm Taking You on a Path You Haven't Travelled"

Life as a son is a journey of experience, change, and transformation. It's like taking a world tour for the first time and experiencing all the sights, sounds, tastes, scenery, and people in every location for the first time. I haven't done that, but looking at various places in movies, TV series, and on Youtube videos, I get a good impression of what that would be like.

If a person's journey to maturity as a son, while they work in partnership with the King, isn't awesome, with regular changes in variety and experiences, they are missing out on what's available to them. Putting aside the negative situations and circumstances they find themselves in, their spiritual life should have many varied experiences as the King grows them to be able to function out of Heaven onto the face of the Earth.

There are seasons where sons face change and move into new things. There are wilderness and testing times when nothing much happens until we're in the right mindset and spiritual level – or we've decided to be compliant with the King's instructions.

Whenever we face unfamiliar spaces, we tend to balk at experiences which are foreign to us. Hesitating is not the Kingdom way, so we need to develop the attitude that what our King sets up for us is going to stretch us so we grow spiritually. That's the attitude he wants us to have, as he confirmed recently:

*"You have a tendency to worry about where to go from here, but you need to remember that I am with you to show you the way day by day. I will give you the wisdom and direction you need to forge ahead," says the Lord. "These are very strange and sometimes stressful times, but **you will grow spiritually through it all.**"*<sup>1</sup>

*"You are in a peculiar spiritual space where some things that have been familiar are now strangely foreign. Go with the flow because **I am taking you on a path you have not travelled** which will expand your view of who I am and what I can and will do in your life. Prepare yourself to be stretched," says the Lord.*"<sup>2</sup>

Remember, we don't grow as a person if we don't let life's experiences stretch us, so we need to ensure that we adopt that attitude to our journey in sonship. Otherwise, we'll never reach our spiritual potential in this life or mature greatly as a son.
