



Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you. I want you to see what Jesus is saying here because he makes a big statement and then he dissects it to provide the meaning

Here's what he said...

Holy Spirit will convict the world concerning:

- •Sin: "Because they do not believe in Me"
- Righteousness: "Because I go to My Father and you see Me no more"
- Judgement: "Because the ruler of this world is judged"

He showed everyone what righteousness was, but now HS will do that job

There's nothing in what Jesus said to bring fear that he'll bring judgement on us because of our sin.

Instead, Judgement <u>has already taken place</u>, and it was of Satan, not us.
