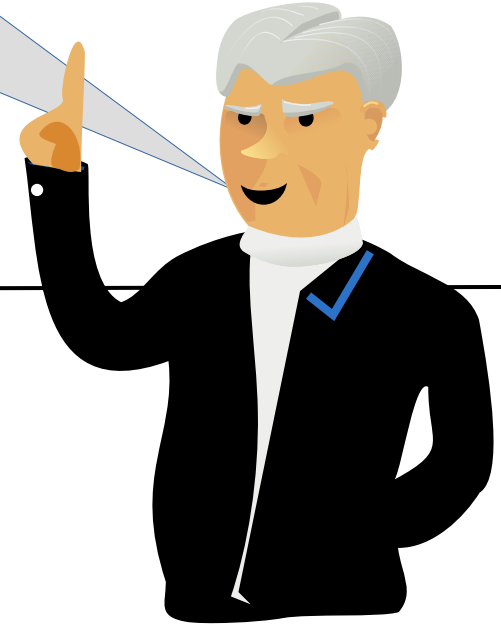

It’s illogical to think otherwise.

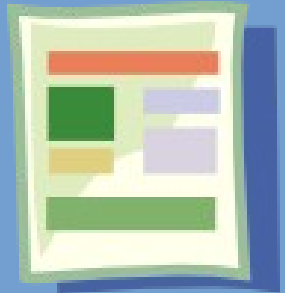
Where they've told us through the Spirit in the NT to love in a particular way, it must be because that's how they love.

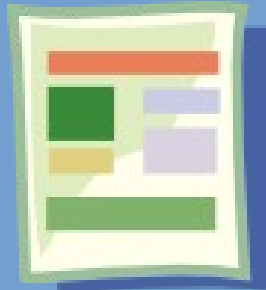

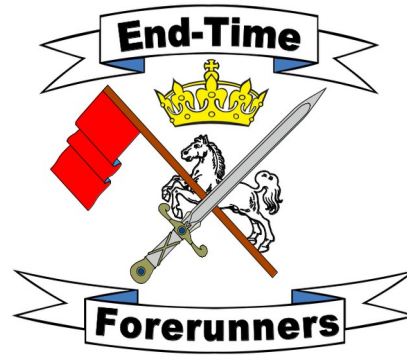
What Kriston Couchey was shown:
