

Is Modern Advancement Totally Alien to the Kingdom?

Certainly, the world system and our societies are not of the Kingdom (unrighteous at the foundation), but what about all the good that's come about through inventions and discoveries? Are they unrighteous as well? It would certainly seem so, from an evangelical perspective at least, which sees anything secular as ungodly.

However, the alienation of societal advancement from having anything to do with the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth is a religious idea, not one the Trinity would agree with. How can I speak for them on this topic? I can say it simply because of the feedback we've receive from them and from what those who visited Heaven have been shown and told.

That being said, not everything that is invented or developed in society is righteous or has a righteous origin. That's obvious. Apart from that, our needs as a society and the desire for the Trinity to see us using our creativity for the betterment of others, is one aspect of the Kingdom that many miss in their zeal to be 'holy'. Of course, that's religious and legalistic, not the holiness we already have as sons.

Let me explain modern advancement from an OT perspective.

When Israel went into the land Canaan, it was described to them by Yahweh as "flowing with milk and honey"¹. He also described it as "a land with brooks, streams, and deep springs gushing out into the valleys and hills; a land with wheat and barley, vines and fig trees, pomegranates, olive oil and honey; a land where bread will not be scarce and you will lack nothing."². Reading those statements in scripture, one would nod in agreement and say, "That's great. He's ensuring that their need for food is met because food means life." However, did you know he also made other plans for them? They were plans relating to life as a nation, which were in addition to their essential life needs.

(1) He wanted them to have cities to live in, as well as villages and farming communities:

*"So I gave you a land on which you did not toil and cities you did not build; and you live in them and eat from vineyards and olive groves that you did not plant."*³

Moses: "*Build cities for your women and children, and pens for your flocks*"⁴

(2) He also supplied raw materials for them so they could work with metals:

*"...a land where the rocks are iron and you can dig copper out of the hills."*⁵

The construction of cities and smith-ing with iron and copper are creative activities that originate in people from inspiration, ingenuity and creativity. These were all things he wanted them to continue with as he transitioned them from a nomadic life to a fixed one. Although not under the New Covenant (NC), it's plain from what the Lord did with his people in relation to building and metalwork were not unrighteous. This comes against other religious ideas

There is an ideology in the church system that 'God'⁶ never wanted nations and that we should live in tents, rather than cities. This is either a religious or super-spiritual concept (or both) which has no basis except in a modern interpretations of scripture. These ideas are no different to the doctrine of the past, that there should be no inter-racial marriages for Christians because 'God' told the Israelites not to marry with the other nations.⁷

6 – 'God': I use this term in inverted commas because 'God' is the generic term people use, while I don't any more. I have an intimate relationship with the members of the Trinity, so I refer to them by name out of relationship. Out of my oneness with them, I also refer to them as The Trinity.

That idea, of course, is irrelevant under the NC⁸, as are many others which are based on Bible passages.

So, in the Kingdom (i.e. under the NC) what should we believe is acceptable? I've just shown how confusing it is when the OT is used to make doctrines, so biblical justification is not always the way to go. The answer to the question is always to find out from Heaven, what we need to know. The Spirit always always teaches us truth and current knowledge, so that's where we go and receive.

Here's a transcript of what Justin Abraham was shown in Heaven about modern inventions:

"I saw technology that was like magic. We are entering a time when technology will be unbelievable. The Lord showed me holographic technology, gravity technology. We'll even harness the power of gravity and be able to have walls you can walk on. It'll change architecture. I saw a road that you could drive on which was on a wall. Jesus was standing next to me. He said we're going to harness the power of gravity and even have restaurants on walls, all kinds of things. We're going to harvest energy. We're going to have limitless energy. Life spans are going to increase exponentially. A better world will emerge. I was shown we'll be able to recycle pretty much anything. I was shown even computers will be bio-organic technology that's recyclable."⁹

On visits to Heaven, others have seen rooms full of inventions that are ready to be released to the world, not just Christians.

All that means that our King doesn't require us to follow the Amish and go back to travelling in horse and carts, ditch our mobile phones and computers, and live on the farm. Some of us may be directed to do that, but others won't. Technological advancement is going to continue with the King's approval, so we can't say it's ungodly.

Our personal responsibility, then, is to ask him questions about what he wants us to believe and to do, so we are in alignment with his plans for us. There's no other alternative.

8 – “The Old Testament Law commanded the Israelites not to engage in interracial marriage (Deuteronomy 7:3–4). However, the reason for this command was not skin color or ethnicity. Rather, it was religious. The reason God commanded against interracial marriage for the Jews was that people of other races were worshippers of false gods. The Israelites would be led astray from God if they intermarried with idol worshippers, pagans, or heathens. This is exactly what happened in Israel, according to Malachi 2:11.”
