

This means that people come in one after the other, like cows, instead of all at the same time.





Scows are flat bottom barges that serviced the Australian coastal communities for centuries. In the harbour, they come and go, one after the other, instead of all at the same time.




Could you immediately accept the change from "cows" to "scows", <u>or</u> did you feel reticence to do that?






A Challenge from Dr Bruce Wauchope: "God: Who and Why Pt 1"





We always <u>were</u> in union with God because the whole of creation is in him, and we're part of creation


Jesus came to open our eyes to <u>that</u> reality, so we could become the sons we were created to be



This concept is wrong

The majority of the other concepts in evangelical Gospel of Salvation are wrong

Take a look



The Gospel of Salvation is very, very dodgy

It doesn't align with Father's reality

Our evangelisation is to introduce people to their Creator and let them know that he accepts them because there's no barrier between us and him.

Any unrighteousness (sin) has been dealt with, so we can freely come to him.

His Son, King Jesus, is now the Sovereign Majesty, ruling over the whole created realm.

Each person's responsibility is to give allegiance to him.

Once in Father's family, he will train us as his sons to partner with him and King Jesus in managing planet Earth.

The King's Kingdom provides benefits for all who become citizens of it.

It's about time every one of us listened to Father and followed him, not the teachings of men
