## **Love Brings Authority and Power**

I've worked at being more loving for years now, with some success. What I have discovered through revelation and prophetic downloads is that our human love is not what's required for sons to manifest. Human love which is compassionate and affectionate is just the <u>base level</u> for loving others. It's Father's love that Jesus had, because he was the perfect image of him, and that's exactly what we need.

To exhibit his love we need to pursue his love. We need to imbibe his love and be saturated by it. Only then can we release it to others. Father told Kriston Couchey that very same thing:

"My instruction to my children is simple – 'Pursue my love'. For the measure of authority and power you walk in is directly related to the extent to which your love has been replaced by my love. The more you love from my love, the more you will be enabled to express Me. Many pursue obedience and fail to pursue my Love. Pursuing obedience apart from love is self-righteousness. The one who loves Me wholeheartedly does my will. Embracing oneness with Me enables you to be perfected in my love. Pursue love by continuing to embrace my love in oneness." 1

## Notice what he said:

- 1. The amount of power and authority we have and can use is in direct proportion to how much of his love we have.
- 2. The more of his love we have, the more others will be able to experience Father through us.
- 3. Pursuing obedience without pursuing love is just self-righteousness.
- 4. The only way we can do what Father wants is to do is if we love him wholeheartedly.
- 5. Maturing in oneness with Father is the way to have his love properly established in us.

So, for sons, there's a lot more to love than just agapē.
