

Love is Our Plumline, Not the Bible

Our measure of truth (fact, reality) is love. That's the plumline the Trinity have informed humanity to use when assessing anything and everything. That's because they operate in pure, unconditional love, and will never change from that functionality – it's their character. Everything from them is based on love, so everything we do and say should be based on love also, and that includes our attitudes. They set the standard for sons, so sons need to adhere to their standard, as best they can.

Now, the caveat to assessing everything by measuring it against love is that the love we use in our assessment must be Father's love, not human love. The fallacy in using the wrong love to measure things has been exemplified in society for all to see, even in recent times. For example:

- The love proponents of free sex in the Sexual Revolution¹ (1960s)
- The love proponents of the 'Peace Not War' Peace Movement² who were angry protesters (1970s)
- The love proponents of the 'don't discriminate against AIDS' activism movement³ (1980s)
- The love proponents of gay love the Gay Revolution⁴ (2010s)
- The love proponents of the 'I love refugees' movement⁵ who are angry demonstrators (2010-2020s)
- The love proponents of the transgender movement⁶ who are violent against dissenters (2020s)

Christians aligned with many of these, but they were not based on Father's love. Instead, they were based on human love, sympathy, compassion, lust, rights, fear, self-defence, and many other emotions and devices.

IMPORTANT: Hidden within these 'loving' movements is an underground, covert movement to destabilize Western society with the aim of replacing democracy with autocratic socialism – *a la* CCP, Stalin and Pol Pot, and as seen in North Korea and Nicaragua today. This covert movement has many fronts or streams of action, which utilize Western Civilization's Christian ethos of loving one another.

Everything we receive as knowledge, teaching, prophecy or directives, must be measured against Father's love. In other words, does it align with or reflect Father's love, not our concept of what love looks like.

By not using Father's love as the benchmark to assess anything is the reason why Christians make so many mistakes when they use the Bible as their 'measuring stick'. That particularly happens with love when they use the Greek form of love, *agapē* (ἀγάπη), to measure anything. *Agapē* love is not Father's genuine love, although his love has an *agapē* component to it. *Agapē* love was the Greek term used by the Hebrew writers as there wasn't any that perfectly captured Father's love. In fact Greek *storgē* love (στοργή) – a mother's family love – is also a useful term for Father's love as he is tender and compassionate, just like a loving mother is to her children.⁷

Only by knowing and experiencing his love are we able to use his love to make assessments. That experience only really comes from an intimate relationship with him, especially oneness.

The Conclusive Test

Beliefs need to be tested as well as our attitudes, speech and actions. Do our beliefs measure up to being an expression of his love? That's the question we should ask ourselves, and when the answer is "NO", the belief should be dismissed. This is actually our part in the process Father takes us through to be deprogrammed and reprogrammed from societal and religious beliefs.

Really, the best way to assess any of our beliefs is to ask Father about them. He's the source of truth (what's real), just as The Son is the source of truth because he is The Truth. Either of them are able to give us an assessment of whether anything we believe is in line with them, and with Kingdom and spiritual reality. It doesn't matter what we believe from reading the Bible or Christian books, or from what we receive from pulpit teaching, it all needs to align with Father's (and our King's) heart and mind.

Our Test

Our group specifically asked Father about love being our plumbline. Here's his complete reply:

"I have a plumbline and it's staring you in the face. For millennia my people have been looking at plumblines, other than the ones that I've set before them. The main plumbline for you to measure everything, including you lives, is love. Not earthly love, not sexual love, not emotional love, but my love.

My love is palpable. When you connect with somebody who distributes my love, you will feel it. It's like coming into my presence when you're with them. This is the plumbline I gave my disciples. [Unfortunately]⁸ it has been set up as (turned into)⁹ a law, and made legalistic, when it's [really] about filling yourself up with my love and allowing me to pour it out on everyone you meet, and on every situation that you're in.

We have been instructing you about love and the importance of it for quite sometime now, because that is the weapon that you use to defeat the culture around you and oppositions to your faith. It's the weapon I used when I was on Earth. Which brings me to your second plumbline.

I am your second plumbline. When I was Jesus of Nazareth, I demonstrated what life should be like. I demonstrated in a practical way how to live in the Kingdom. And, as you have all been brought into the Kingdom, when you chose to make me your Lord and King, I am your plumbline. Read up on how I interacted with others. Read up on how I spoke. Look for how I dealt with issues with forgiveness and grace and mercy, how I was compassionate to everyone.

I opposed religion because religion is fake, it's a substitute for life in the Kingdom. We never set up any religion and the New Covenant which I introduced, was to be an open relationship with us, not a religion. So, for that matter, religion is NOT your plumbline and those who are religious, are not your benchmark. I am your prototype, your benchmark, the one you model your life on. There is no other. Don't look to men, look to me. Men will cause you to be sidelined, whereas, I won't.

The other plumbline that you are to assess everything with is, "Is it righteous. Does it belong in the Kingdom of Heaven, and therefore in the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth?" That requires discernment, which is why I released my Spirit to you all, and why I said that my Spirit will lead you into all truth, and will teach you everything you need to know. So, if he speaks to you personally or corporately, and you discern that it is from him, and therefore from me, that is a plumbline.

*That is my message to you, which you need to align with, and carry out."*¹⁰
