

The Reality of the New Covenant

(A conversational prophetic message recorded on the 22nd February 2023)

Question: *Lord, there's a lot of misconception about how to properly live in your New Covenant. What is your message to your people in Australia about this?*

Message #1

NOTE: There are a number of areas about the New Covenant that our King covered in this message in regard to matters that believers need understanding. These have been listed as points.

(1) The New Covenant, which is between Father, myself and humanity, is quite simple. It's about a love relationship. It's about family. It's about being together. It's also about peace and tranquillity, but it involves work. That should be familiar to you all because it's just like life in the natural. In Western society, there is family, family relationships and family situations, and there is work time and work experiences. These all go together to make life in Australia today. That's quite a simple analogy, but you all accept that sort of life because it's what you've been raised in and it's your culture. I want you to transfer that to the New Covenant: it's about life with us and working together. It's as simple as that.

(2) There's nothing onerous about our relationship in the New Covenant. As I said, it's a love-relationship. It's about us bonding together, Father and sons, seeing me as your older brother, and being in an intimate relationship. Not a filial or familial relationship, but a deep relationship.

(3) As we are 'the head', the New Covenant is about allowing us to be in charge (just like good parents [are in charge of their children]¹), and we oversee your lives and look after you. We want to draw you in closer, closer than you are in your natural family life. As parents desire to share life and prepare their children for the future, we do as well. Father and I want the best for you, so we're training you and preparing you for what's ahead in your life. Beyond that, we are preparing humanity for the future. We do that out of love, like parents do, but the difference is, there's no scolding, no punishment. It's about drawing you in to the plans that we have.

(4) Of course, like children, you have the autonomy to make your own decisions, and to rebel and go your own way. Under the New Covenant, we let you go. We don't hold you in constraints, in legalism, with laws and rules. So the decisions you make in life have consequences, but they do not impact how we love you. It doesn't smear your reputation with us. It doesn't cause us to expel you from the family, or to dissociate ourselves from you. By the same token, you don't have to do things to win our favour. In the relationship we have together under the New Covenant, there's none of that. In fact, it's futile, because our love for you is so strong and so big, and the blood covenant covers your waywardness, so we can see you as [the person] we really want to see you grow up and mature into. AND WE LOVE YOU.

(5) In the natural realm, parents set rules and regulations to keep their children under control. We don't do that. In this New Covenant, this 'love covenant', it's about wanting you and desiring you to align yourselves with us, to love us, to partner with us and to move deeper into oneness with us. Our heart is that you operate out of the love that we pour into you. It's been called 'The Royal Law'², but in fact, there is no law, it's about manifesting in your life the love that we pour into you. Laws cause you to focus on yourself, trying to 'measure up', 'dotting the Is and crossing the Ts', as it were.

(6) In a loving natural family, children do things to please their parents, or they do things in ways that exemplify the love that they have together. They desire to do things rightly, rather than to be given a set of laws and rules that they must do, which puts a burden on them and creates fear. There is none of that³ in our relationship under the New Covenant. That seems illogical to most people because they're used to living under laws, rules, regulations and protocols. But that's because humanity doesn't operate out of our love. Love doesn't draw people together in the natural, in the way our love draws you to us. Instead, people have to invent ways of coercing others into doing things their way, with punishment. Rules, regulations and the like, set the rules, the ground work, that describes behaviour. Not so, in the New Covenant.

(7) We draw you in. We love you. We never stop loving you. Once people experience our love, and move into oneness with us – like I did with Father when I was on Earth – it's a place where people want to stay. Out of that relationship, they live their life. As we mold⁴ and shape them through life's circumstances and through what we communicate to them spiritually, they operate more and more out of our character, because they love us and desire to be a blessing to us.

(8) For those who choose to live under the New Covenant, there's absolutely no requirement to live under any of the

Old Covenant, because the Old Covenant was abolished and a new one put in place. The new one expresses who we are. The old one was what the Children of Israel desired because of their time in Egypt living under laws and regulations which pertained not only to their society, but to the gods that were in the land. The Old Covenant has nothing to do with the New Covenant. I desire my people to operate completely in the New Covenant. Do not fear that you are contradicting the Old Covenant, which you find in the Old testament, because any time you fear, it has nothing to do with us. We do not bring fear: we bring love, wholeness and peace.

(9) Under the New Covenant, it's not about looking to the past, reading about the past, it's about living in the here-and-now, with us. The New Covenant is a living relationship, not a religion. My people must get that. It's often expressed as "Kingdom life" or "life in the Kingdom", because the New Covenant introduced the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth. It's a wonderful life, and that's the life of the New Covenant. It's not a theological thing 'to get your head around', it's about no more rules and regulations, no more punishment, no more compulsion, but rest⁵ and peace, love, fellowship and intimacy, co-operation and partnership.

(10) Going back to my first analogy to explain the New Covenant, it's about family. The New Covenant brings you back into the family that Adam was in, originally. [In it,] you are spotless, sinless, because of the work of the cross. So, life should be one of trusting us and resting in us, communicating with us, spirit-to-Spirit, and moving on with the work we have together, and with the lives we've provided for you on planet Earth. Simple, just like children growing up in their own families. It's normal and natural, and it's our desire that you see the New Covenant that way.

(11) So, you need to get rid of your legalism and all religious activity and thought patterns, change your mind to our mind (which is what 'repent' means) and live the wonderful life that we have for you, without fear, without bondage. Freedom and liberty are yours. Why not give it your whole heart, and stop living in both covenants, to 'hedge your bets', just in case. Be bold and step out. Commit yourself wholeheartedly to our family relationship, and under the New Covenant, you'll find that life is wonderful.

(12) To answer your question, it would take a large amount of time. Suffice to say, what I've described [above] is our New Covenant relationship, because that's what it [really] is. Out of that relationship we work together on Earth on the plans that we have for humanity and for the natural realm."

Message #2

"Can you see now that quoting from the Old Testament is living in the Old Covenant, even though there were appropriate spiritual statements and writings back then? The New Covenant is about [your] relationship with us right now. You don't need to go back to the past. The New Covenant brings intimate relationship with us, so that out of your connection with us, you will know what you need to know about spiritual life and how to live in the Kingdom in the natural realm.

We teach you as parents – as good parents. We teach you how to live, and you can ask us any questions you like, and we'll give you the answers. We are the source of all knowledge, so ask us. You don't need to draw on somebody else's emotional feelings and spiritual highs that are written in the past⁶. Living in oneness with us, or even an intimate relationship with us, we will meet all your personal needs, including all your emotional and love needs, which are essential for the stability of people in life. Under the New Covenant, you draw everything from us – everything. That's where your alignment has to be. We will meet your needs, we guarantee it.

So, stop living out of the Old Testament, and living in other people's revelations. Everything is new for you. Connect with us and we will infuse in you everything you need, everything you need to know, and you'll live life in the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth as you were created to.

Don't make it complex. Don't put pressure on yourself to come up to a certain standard. Rest and relax, and put your effort into your relationship with us, and in your relationships with other people. This part of the New Covenant is about freedom and needs being met. Take hold of it. There's more to the New Covenant through our relationship together, than you can ever, ever imagine."
