Been there, done that. I've been part of spiritual groups, especially prophetic worshippers and professional Christians, where I've seen their lives and their families in disarray. You see, we tend to strongly believe that worship is an activity, when it's being connected spiritually.

I was drawn on from all that and into oneness which has no external activity attached to it. Contrary to common belief, it's intended for sons that activity flows out of oneness, which is what Jesus of Nazareth demonstrated.
