

# Make Righteous Choices

In the Kingdom we use Kingdom terms (Kingdom jargon) instead of religious or Christian jargon. The switch to Kingdom terminology requires deprogramming and reprogramming, so that there's no fear in using Kingdom language, instead of that which we've been taught by religion.

One such appropriate switch in terms is using the word 'righteous'<sup>1</sup> – the opposite of which is 'unrighteous'<sup>2</sup>. The main reason for the switch to using these words is that they properly reflect what Father desires in our behaviour.<sup>3</sup>

With that in mind, expressions like 'holiness movement' or 'be holy' are outmoded in the Kingdom. In fact, they are irrelevant<sup>4</sup> because we are already holy in Father's sight through the work of the cross. Actually, we can't be any more holy than we already are.

The important point here is that we need to change the way we speak as sons. As an example, our King provided instructions recently in which he used 'righteous' in the way we are to use it. He stated:

*“Remember that you have embarked on a new era. You have come full circle and will have opportunities to begin again. But, you will have to **take every opportunity to make more righteous choices** this time around. Keep your focus clearly on doing what will produce the best outcome morally and spiritually,” says the Lord. “Refuse to allow selfish ambition to drive you.”*<sup>5</sup>

So, the choices we make voluntarily, outside of what the Spirit shows us, must be righteous. That means they aren't holy choices, they're to be in line with the King's heart, mind and desires. After all, that's what righteous really means in the Kingdom.<sup>6</sup>
