

'My Current Opinion is the Only One That Matters'

At this time in the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth, sons are being taught to live the way humanity was originally designed to live at Creation. This current change in direction for believers¹, away from the Christian religion, was meant to have taken place from the very start of the New Covenant's introduction in the 1st century. However, the force of paganism and Judaism among the first believers appears to have been so strong, that the Christian religion had started to manifest very soon after the death of the last Apostle.²

One of the critical functions of sonship that was lost very early on (say, by the start of the 2nd century) was the ability to hear from the Trinity using Spirit-to-spirit communication. The important source of spiritual knowledge had become the writings of those elders who were seen as being very spiritual, rather than every person hearing from Father or Jesus with their spirit. This down-graded method of knowledge receipt was from the influence of Greek and Jewish practices of honouring and esteeming significant writings, both cultures being dominant in the 1st century. By the time the Bible was finally formulated (canonised) in the 4th century from the ancient Hebrew writings, the historic records concerning Jesus' life, and the letters written by the Apostles, Christians had become used to learning from spiritual writings.

The veneration of these Christian texts (*a la* Jewish style)³ then morphed into becoming holy scripture, and eventually The Holy Bible. Gone were the loving, personal communications that the Trinity wanted to have with their imagers⁴, but that did begin to resurface in the 20th century. Up to that time teaching was received from the pulpit, religious books, seminaries (theological colleges), and from personal Bible reading. These methods were not what was expected of sons under the New Covenant. The revitalization of spiritual hearing worldwide, in large numbers, began with the Pentecostal movement of the early 1900s⁵ and continues to the present time.



Today, Father is raising up sons who are committed to working with him and the King on Kingdom business. This includes instruction through Spirit-to-spirit communication, which is the only way he can give directions regarding the day-to-day handling of life's situations and circumstances. The accuracy of hearing from him is vital for directions and personal wisdom to be received 24/7. Downloads are essential for this, so therefore, intuition, dreams and visions, angelic visitation, etc. are of very little use with this need for relational communication, as we partner with him on his plans and purposes in the world.

Here's an example of what he's been saying to us about hearing straight from him, not the Bible or church leaders. (NOTE: The person who received this message is still in the church system, so Father has spoken to her using some church jargon, ones which she uses and understands.)

“Refuse to allow the opinions of others to set your course. Listen only to my still small voice for direction, correction, and purpose. Everybody has an opinion; some good and others not so good, but you can only depend on me to lead you in the way you should go,” says the Lord. “I am with you always.””⁶

His subsequent instructions advise us to hear from him on all occasions and for all situations. He has the plans for our lives (as well as all of humanity), and his wisdom that he releases to us personally will allow

us to fit in with his plans and purposes. Here's what he said:

*"Allow your motivation to come from me," says the Lord. "There are plenty of people who want to influence you to meet their needs and desires, but that is not your calling. I will prompt you in ways that will bring interest, inspiration, encouragement, and spiritual growth."*⁷

"Be sensitive to how I am directing your steps, and refuse to allow outside pressure from other people to take you off course. My plan and purpose for you is intact and will serve you well if you stay the course," says the Lord."⁸

Mike Parsons' experience supports my experience, that the way we're meant to receive spiritual knowledge and wisdom for life on Earth is by hearing what the Trinity has to say to us personally. He's recently taught:

*"At the end of the day, the Holy Spirit is in us. The Father, Son, and Spirit are in us and with us. They're there to guide us and direct us. And they don't need a book to do it."*⁹

The Bible and Christian books are very limited in being able to speak to us about what we need to know in the 21st century, in comparison to hearing directly from Father. In regard to learning from sources other than directly from the Spirit, Mike states:

*"I'm not going to follow Enoch. I'm going to follow God. You know, and that's the key. Never ever getting caught up with anyone who's not God, but being able to learn as God uses angels or uses the cloud witnesses to speak to us at times, but primarily he still wants to speak to us directly. Firsthand experience of God is always going to be better than secondhand. And even if it is the cloud of witnesses or angels, they're still communicating through their own experience or understanding. Now, they may communicate directly what God said. Great. Then you're going to hear what God said. But I would be rather wanting to hear what God said to me, primarily, rather than through an angel. And I think in all this, let's learn to discern hearing the voice of the spirit. Discern hearing Jesus's voice. Let's get to know the Father. Let's get to be intimate. Engage heart to heart, face to face. Know what the Father's like. Know what love is rather than trying to figure it out reading a whole load of books."*¹⁰
