

No 10 Commandments or Laws to Follow in the Kingdom

I'm constantly challenged by others that the OC Laws or the Ten Commandments (or some other rules) are essential for believers. I've even received a treatise from a prophetic person calling my idea as an error from the past.

The only thing I can say is that I need to check and see what Father has had to say about laws, rules and regulations in his communication with us.

The result of over 15 years operating prophetically, I have never received a prophetic message that had anything in it about adhering to any legal entity – never. Neither have I heard it contained in any prophetic messages that I've read from trusted prophetic sources, whether they were given to me personally or distributed on the Internet.

As an example of this absence of a legal framework, check out this message from Father yesterday. In it, his injunction for being his representative to the world has nothing to do with legalism. What he wants is for us to become more like him in character and operation:

“You are My emissary, a representative of the Kingdom of God, and it is My desire that you strive to represent My character and nature in all that you are and all that you do. It is just as easy to do right as it is to do wrong, but you have the power to choose to be a worthy ambassador.”¹

The only content that remotely relates to legalism is his instruction to do what's right. You'd think that this would be an opportunity for him to make it very clear that the Torah or the Ten Commandments are mandatory. But, No. The instruction is to do what's right.

Remember, 'right' means 'righteous', or, in other words, what he'd approve of us doing or saying.

Father made it very clear to us in a prophetic message² that he wants us to live fully in the New Covenant, not in the Old Covenant with its laws and regulations. Here's a small extract from it:

“Under the New Covenant, we let you go. We don't hold you in constraints, in legalism, with laws and rules. So the decisions you make in life have consequences, but they do not impact how we love you. It doesn't smear your reputation with us. It doesn't cause us to expel you from the family, or to dissociate ourselves from you. By the same token, you don't have to do things to win our favour. In the relationship we have together under the New Covenant, there's none of that. In fact, it's futile, because our love for you is so strong and so big, and the blood covenant covers your waywardness, so we can see you as [the person] we really want to see you grow up and mature into. AND WE LOVE YOU.”³

So, we're not to mix covenants. We're not to live with our mind and beliefs in both covenants.
