

Our King Says: “Never do anything to be noticed or appreciated”

It’s always very important to hear what the members of the Trinity have to say to us. Their message – however long or short – will be very relevant to the 21st century, and to our modern lives and circumstances.

It’s true that what they have to say will sometimes be similar to what we may read in the Bible, but that’s not an excuse to switch off spiritually hearing and stick to reading ‘sacred scripture’.

Here’s one of our King’s recent teachings to speak to our spirit on how to live life as a son:

*“**Never do anything to be noticed or appreciated; self-interest and seeking approval** is not a good look for you. Set your sights higher and come up in the Spirit to do all that I have called you to do – those things that are pleasing to me,” says the Lord. “Life is not a contest to prove that you can out do others. Humility is the order of the day.””¹*

Notice that he’s unmasking our propensity to be competitive in life, when humility is what he’s wanting.

Note also, that he’s looking for us to do those things which are pleasing to him. Those are the things which are righteous – not in a legalistic sense. Righteous activity is what he wants in any given situation, which is why we need his training, his mind, and his wisdom.
