

REMINDER: Stay Focused

In February 2013, as part of my first prophetic journal entry, Father said to me “Focus, focus, focus”. This began the long process of his work on me to get me to remain focused (focussed¹), because my future depended on it. The context on that occasion was this:

“This is imperative – do not give up – much is reliant on you. Focus, focus, focus. Don’t lose your focus of me or the task ahead. Be tunnel-visioned so you don’t deviate right or left. Trust me. Trust only me. Others will let you down. Others will attempt to distract you and draw you away with the affairs of this world. DO NOT listen to the distractions. I will give you the discernment you need to remain focused, on task. The distractions will be strong – delusional – but my goal will be before you and you are to aim for that. No deviation – straight forward to the goal.”²

This focus training has continued unabated. In October 2016, I was told not to focus on the city of Canberra, but on my street and my local community. This wasn’t a completely new focus as I’d been told previously, by our King, that he wants a Kingdom Community on every street so that cities can be ‘taken’ for him.

In October 2019, Father told me to make changes to our Kingdom Living Community gatherings to help us transition into the ‘new ekklesia’ he was producing around the world. We then began to focus on how that transformation would take place, where every member has an active function.

To “stay focused” isn’t a new instruction for us. In 2018, Father told our Community to do just that.³ At that time, he even gave us teaching on how to remain focused on the Kingdom,⁴ as we were learning how to live properly as sons.

Over the past few years, he’s also been telling us to remain focused all the time in life, so that negative situations and circumstances don’t eventuate which could have easily been avoided. These negativities are used by the enemy to distract us from our focus on the Kingdom, so we become less effective in what we achieve.

Over the past year (2020-2021) he has been telling us to focus on a number of important things:

- The King and the Kingdom in this critical new era.⁵
- What he has to say to us rather than what’s in the Bible.⁶
- What he’s doing.⁷
- His big picture view.⁸
- The Internal Kingdom.⁹
- Impacting individuals with the Kingdom.¹⁰
- What can do, not what we can’t do.¹¹
