Reminder: Learn to be Frugal

This is a reminder to develop various levels of frugal living in all areas of your life, including that of your family. It's a reminder because our King informed us in 2019 that it's time for frugal living. 2

This move to frugality is more imperative now as we're seeing the advance of the Elite's agenda to destroy societies through chaos, control and financial ruin. Today, through the effects of their program,³ we're see that the King's instruction was a warning of things to come and to prepare for it. He didn't keep us in the dark about the future and he never will.

Our King will, however, only inform us of what we need to know – not a bit more. In a recent message from him he told us why. Here's an extract of it:

"I don't need to alarm you by telling you the things that are coming, because it's not your prerogative to know everything. Your responsibility is to operate and function where you know you have to, and where I show you, and leave the rest to me. I know it's human's inquisitive nature to want to know the future and what's going on, but that's not trusting me. Get over that. Get over the desire to want to know everything and to know the future. Live for today. Enjoy today."

Knowing too much of the future is like thinking too much about it. For example: I've been getting information on economic collapse for about 5 years now, but no GFC2 has eventuated over that time. Each warning was dire and imminent, but nothing happened. It's best, therefore, to do what our King told us in that message, to trust him implicitly, just as we trust a chair when we sit on it.

So, with what we see today (without thinking the worst of the future) the need is now more urgent to be frugal with our finances.

Any problems we have now and in the future will be of our own making. That will be because we're not operating out of the King's wisdom⁵ and following his instructions.
