## Revealing the Precepts of God

From reading the OT in the KJV and NKJV, our understanding of the term 'precept' is a legal one, relating to 'God's' law (Torah). However, the term is not in the NT, because we're not under the Old Covenant (OC).

It was interesting, then, to hear Mike Parsons use the term in relation to his engagement with Father. Here's what he had to say:

"That is what I feel is going on right now. There's a revealing of the precepts of God which is Creator for creation. He wants his sons to come into the knowledge of that reality, so that when we become creators, we will be able to operate in the same heart and the same mind towards that which we create. And I fully believe that God is trying to teach us to operate out of that mindset and that way of thinking and that heart of love, compassion, the oracles of his heart. The Oracles of his heart his passion for creation – all of it – his intense Joy."<sup>2</sup>

To get a proper understanding of what Father has taught him, we must eliminate any OT thinking that we still have remaining in our brain. To help with our understanding, we need to see what 'precept' actually means.

DEFINITION: Precept (plural precepts)
Noun – A rule or principle, especially one governing personal conduct.<sup>3</sup>

That means 'God's precepts' are what governs the way he operates. As the proverb states: "Precept guides, but example draws". He is guided in the way he deals with us and creation through his character of love. That's why we have unlimited grace and mercy in the New Covenant (NC) – that's his character which determines (guides) how he operates with us. Another guiding principle (precept) that he follows is that, as his imagers, we were also created as creators, and he wants us to regain that functionality. It was lost with The Fall, but since the Kingdom was restored, this is guiding him in where he's taking his sons, so they fulfil their destiny.

Notice also that Mike uses the term 'oracles', an archaic word that also needs explanation. Of course, the need for explanation is even greater if a person has an OT mindset where 'oracles' relates to 'God's' commands through his prophets – another legalistic idea.

DEFINITION: Oracle (plural oracles)
Noun – A wise sentence or decision of great authority.<sup>5</sup>

This means 'the oracles of God' are his decisions about how he will operate (function) towards creation. The 'oracles of his heart' are, therefore, his heart towards us and creation.

Here's the full section of what Mike conveyed about Father's precepts and oracles:

"That is what God is wanting, a global awakening of consciousness to the reality of love, which will then be the desire for The Restoration Of All Things. So, it is a constant desire within the heart and mind of God, and the thoughts of God, because his thoughts are always good...He wants us to discover the amazing thoughts about us which will bring a revelation of identity, sonship and government, to bring about The Restoration Of All Things, because we'll love people and love creation the way he loves it.

That is what I feel is going on right now. There's a revealing of the precepts of God which is Creator for creation. He wants his sons to come into the knowledge of that reality, so that when we become creators, we will be able to operate in the same heart and the same mind towards that which we create. And I fully

believe that God is trying to teach us to operate out of that mindset and that way of thinking and that heart of love, compassion, the oracles of his heart. The Oracles of his heart, his passion for creation – all of it – [and] his intense joy.

See, God doesn't look at creation and see what it isn't. God looks at creation – including all of us – and sees what he intended. That's why he can still be full of joy when he looks at the world and sees. What does he see? A whole load of people that he's already forgiven and saved and made righteous, operating in the deception of the darkness of their own alienated minds. Well of course he wants to bring the light to bring revelation of truth. Then they will be added to the mind that thinks in a restoration way...

I feel it. I sense the groan, the longing, the waiting for us to be revealed in our sonship to bring about its freedom into our glory. [That's] because God gave us creation to rule and govern as sons and therefore creation will be set free from its boldest corruptions into the freedom of the glory of the children of God. So, only our glory will bring about creation's freedom, which is why we need to radiate and shine with light. Which means having that mind which is in agreement with God, which is true repentance – agreeing with God about ourselves; agreeing with God about creation; agreeing with God about everybody else – so there is one mind, choosing one reality.'6

Mike is totally convinced from his encounters with Father that he operates out of his loving precepts, and that he can't do it any other way:

"So, we've got to be careful that we are not operating out of our own understanding of these things, but we get everything from our relationship with the Father. The Father has led me on this journey – I had no intention of going down this road...all of those encounters have even more convinced me of how God is love. It cannot be anything else, other than love."

Mike then covers Father's precept of restoration:

"Well, that makes it easier then, to actually believe that God would want to restore everything, even those things that we don't think deserve to be restored. He has a different framework than we do, and as our minds are renewed to think like his, it's easier to accept that he would want to restore every everything he created. And the more I go down that path of engaging love and the depth and the oracles of the Father's heart, and realizing how passionate he is for his creation, it makes total sense to me that he has within the foundation of creation built into it the possibility of everything can be restored."
