

• "Is the Goliath in Autism Research About to Fall?"

"New study cements findings that autism has environmental rather than genetic causes... An extensive meta-analysis of 25 autism studies could shift the focus of research into the cause of autism from genetics to environmental triggers. That shift could open up new, revolutionary avenues for potential treatments. The research ties the disorder to changes in the gut microbiome, a community of microbes that live in the colon and are responsible for creating metabolites and other compounds crucial to our health and wellness."

• "The aerosol transfer of antibodies between immune and non-immune hosts"

ABSTRACT: "Despite the obvious knowledge that infectious particles can be shared through

respiration, whether other constituents of the nasal/oral fluids can be passed between hosts has surprisingly never even been postulated, let alone investigated. The circumstances of the present pandemic facilitated a unique opportunity to fully examine this provocative idea. The data we show provides evidence for a new mechanism by which herd immunity may be manifested, the aerosol transfer of antibodies between immune and non-immune hosts."
