

• "The Real Healing Effects of Placebos on Diseases Are Overshadowed by Drugs"

"Can a placebo alleviate symptoms? Pharmaceutical researchers test new drugs by comparing them to a placebo, a pill that looks like the drug but has no effect. The objective is to determine if the drug is more effective than the placebo. Interestingly, people who take the placebo often experience positive effects. If these effects are equal to those taking the actual drug, the drug is considered unsuccessful. This effect is known as the "placebo effect". Placebo in Latin means "I shall please". It usually represents a type of psychological effect compared to the "real" pharmacological effect of a medication."
