

Speculation on the Future is Not Anchored in Reality

Allowing Father to manage our future is the way sons are meant to function in life. That doesn't mean we don't think about the future and make some plans. We are allowed to make plans, but we must hold them loosely so we're amendable to what Father says to us about them through the Spirit. He works in the foreground (the spirit realm)¹ so the natural (what I call the background)² should follow his plans for the best outcomes.

Anxiousness and worry about our future is caused by focusing too much on our future. That way of operating does not promote or maintain the peace and rest that the Kingdom offers us. Operating in anxiety comes from a lack of trust that Father has everything in control and has the best plans for our future. He lives in reality, so it's best to allow him to have 'the driving seat' while we work with him.

Father says:

*“When you look to the future, you are likely to be afraid of what could happen, or might happen. **Be aware that what you think is ahead for you is pure speculation that is not anchored in reality.** Stay in the moment and take one day at a time to deal with real issues. Never forget that I am your place of safety,” says the Lord.*”³

In addition to being concerned about our future, we can also do it with the prophetic words we've received. Centering on prophetic words about our future is also the wrong way to function as sons, as we won't be anchored in reality, but more than likely, fantasy. Instead, our responsibility is to constantly hear from Father so that he can guide us at any moment of the day when it's required.

NOTE: Actually, we don't need prophetic words if we're hearing through the Spirit for ourselves.
