Stay Calm, Cool and Collected

Today I wrote in a separate teaching article: 'We are powerful as sons, but we don't wield power unless we know we have to. At all times we remain 'cool, calm and collected', assessing situations, listening to the Spirit, and operating in strength and power only when it's absolutely right to do so.'

Tonight I read a message from Father, published yesterday, which reads:

""Set yourself to stay calm, cool and collected when things seem to not be working out the way you intended. Refuse to become irritated or agitated. Take the time to check your attitude and be determined to move through every difficult circumstance with grace and faith in Me to show you a better way," says the Lord. "Quiet your soul.""²

Obviously, there's concurrence in both documents from the Trinity: staying calm, cool and collected is essential for the way sons function out of oneness and rest.
