Superiority Has No Place In The Kingdom

Knowing what belongs in the Kingdom and what doesn't is a vital skill for sons.¹ To do that will require de-programming by Father and then his reprogramming. We have so much 'rubbish' in our minds which we believe he approves of that the mental transformation required will only happen speedily if we agree to it and accept everything we know he is revealing to us.

One thing that is highly valued in Heaven and is, therefore, a component of the Kingdom is humility. In that respect, superiority in any form is an antithesis to humility, so having humility (not weakness) as our maxim should help us eliminate that self-promoting attitude.

We may have been taught that haughtiness (superiority) is inappropriate for believers, but have we really taken a look at ourselves and made an effort to eliminate it when it manifests? Maybe the impetus we need to take action is to receive instructions from Father on the matter. Here's what he stated recently:

""Do not allow divisions to come between you and others because of race, creed, color, physical appearance, politics, or religious affiliation. Rather live and walk in the Spirit and let your love flow for everyone. Superiority and hatred have no place in My Kingdom," says the Lord"²

UXPODUANNUS The destructive divisions mentioned by Father is exactly what the Greek term translated as 'heresy' in the NT actually means. That is, heresy is any kind of division that creates a separation between sons – whether based on either 'good' or 'bad' teaching.
