Talking Sense; Talking Reality

To talk sense in the Kingdom, we need to talk reality. That means, talking about what's real, <u>not</u> what's imaginary or hypothetical. To do that, we have to neglect religion with it's theology, traditions and church dogmas. All those came from people's minds, and so they're not perfect revelations of what's real.

Here's some of what our King said about that recently – sticking with what's real:

"The things of the spirit realm are real. Real is what exists, and what is and has been. It's not in the mind of men¹. As I am reality, I am The Truth. If you speak what is real, you speak the truth. If you receive [and then speak] what I give you, you're speaking the truth that you know, because you've received what's real. Real relates to what is. It's not speculation, it's not theology, it's not a hypothesis, but it's what actually exists. It's actually what has been said, and what actually has been meant by what was said. All my thoughts are reality. All my plans and purposes are reality. Everything I've spoken for a purpose and to specific people, has been a reality. Reality doesn't change – it just is, in the same way that I Am. What's real, is what my people should be seeking, and that's always found in me. It's true that there are real things outside of me, such as those within your life experiences. But, anything else that's outside of your personal experience, needs to come from me, if it's to be absolute reality."

Notice the words I've underlined in the above extract. These show that the search for truth must come from what directly comes from the Throne in Heaven, not via the interpretation of learned people. Even prophetic knowledge needs to be tested (assessed) to check on its reality, and therefore, it's truthfulness.

What sparked this quest to understand reality has been the deposits in my spirit about reality, rather than truth, because of the relativising⁴ of truth among believers. The final impetus for me to write and to ask our King for his mind on reality/truth, came from the following message from him recently:

""You are in a season of progression. You will be able to break through invisible barriers that have kept you from achieving certain goals. If you pay attention, you will discover that you are experiencing a freedom that only comes from realizing <u>spiritual reality</u>. Refuse to believe that living and walking in the Spirit is fragile. It is the most solid existence possible.""⁵

So, to make spiritual sense, we must talk spiritual reality, not human truth. Truth is not equivalent to what's really true (reality), although sometimes it's the same.
