

The Importance of Self-Examination to Get to the Root of Problems

Self-examination is a vital component of the functioning of sons.¹ We should take seriously our need to grow and mature in our sonship,² as well as our representation of the King and the Kingdom to those we come in contact with.³ As his imagers, as well as partners in managing the natural realm, to go around ignorant of what we do and say, and operating out of impulse and reaction,⁴ is not a sign of any sort of maturity.⁵

When we keep tabs on ourselves in a non-condemning way,⁶ we are able to see the unrighteousness that we engage in.⁷ Remembering that unrighteousness is what's not right in Father's eyes⁸ for any activity in any point in time.⁹ It's not about sin – that's been dealt with by the King's life as the man, Jesus of Nazareth.

As a reminder of our need to assess ourselves – or as first instructions for other readers – here is a message from Father to affirm our need to engage in this:

*“There are issues in your life that you need to confront with truth and **righteousness**. You can do this by defining your goals and confronting your resistance to carry out your intentions. This can only be done by **self-examination and getting to the root of the problem**, which is likely to be fear.”¹⁰*

The above message shows us that there are personal reasons for self-examination which will improve our lives.¹¹ That's the more immediate outcome that we will observe, but the cleaning out of 'rubbish' from our soul and mind will occur within us and produce changes in our sonship in the best way, from the inside-out.

NOTE: The above message is a prophetic inspiration distributed from the one who received it. There was no need for them to say/write, “The Lord says...”, “...says the Lord”, etc. in its content. When we receive what the Spirit has downloaded to us, no qualification is required. It's the duty and responsibility of the hearer or reader to discern the veracity of the message. I have written on this in more detail recently.¹²

Here is another download on this topic from the Spirit:

“Set aside time to rest and reevaluate what you have done, what you must do, what you want to do, and how you will go about it. There are places of neglect and regret that need to be rectified as you establish yourself in divine order.”¹³
