## The Way to Find Out About Your Future

Everyone wants to know about their future, even believers<sup>1</sup> do. There are many reasons for that inquisitiveness, but the root cause is often discontent, at one level or another, as the person hopes the future is better than the present. In itself, the desire to know what's going to occur in the future is not wrong. The negative issue surrounding it is the emphasis that's put on it and the sources chosen to supply the insight wanted.

For sons, the answer is simple: The Trinity knows our future, so that's where we're to look. That's also what they want, as they instructed us recently:

"" There are things that I want to reveal to you that you have not yet considered. However, you have to come to me in the spirit to see and understand. Position yourself to receive the revelations of this time in your life," says the Lord, "and I will show you things to come.""<sup>2</sup>

That was very straightforward, so we should function that way and not try to use alternative, 'backdoor' methods to try to find out about our future. Father will show us what we need to know, when he deems it necessary to do so, not before. He will reveal components of our future when we're at the stage in our journey and our sonship maturity, that require the knowledge to be released to us. That's the best way to operate in the Kingdom – living one day at a time and leaving the future to him.

That doesn't mean we can't make plans, because he wants us to do that in partnership with him. These plans of ours will determine our future, just as much as his plans do.

UMPORUANUS Our futures aren't set, because the Trinity has chosen to work with us,<sup>3</sup> giving us autonomy to make our own decisions.<sup>4</sup> They can't know every detail of our future because we make decisions every moment of the waking hours which certainly impacts our future, one way or another.<sup>5</sup>
