Give Yourself Some Space To Just Be Human (24-3-2026)

SOURCE FILE: "KCC MESSAGE: Give Yourself Some Space To Just Be Human"²

1. The King said to "Give Yourself Some Space To Just Be Human".
2. He said it from his heart, not for any other reason.
3. He knows what we're going through as we endeavour to be more mature in our sonship.
4. We constantly have to battle against our soul and mind, as well as what we've learnt from life in society.
5. The thoughts and attitudes that fill our heart and mind are like a maze which constantly block our progress.
6. The King's intent in giving us that instruction was to get us to relax and rest, so we don't put so much pressure on ourselves.
7. His instruction was also to get us to realize that we are human, with many frailties.
8. If we continue to battle against our frailties by striving, it'll only cause us to develop anxiousness, which is not resting in peace.
9. The King's goal for us is for each of us to grow and mature in our sonship, but we have to achieve that in the restrictions that our humanity puts on us.
10. He wants us to use his assistance as we deal with our soul and your mind, just as we rely on him to train us.
11. Reaching maturity will be a long process for us because we've spent most of our lives being controlled by everything other than the Spirit.
12. We shouldn't baulk at having his assistance, because we are who we are today through the work we've done with him as we've moved forward as a person.
13. We can't ignore everything he's covered in his message so far.
14. We can't think less of our humanity and our lives than he does, especially not to abhor our humanity [as some people do].
15. He doesn't see our human frailty as something to loathe because he's already experienced life in human form.
16. He can identify with what each of us go through, including the pressures we face.
17. His experience of life on Earth with Father teaches him that the way to succeed is to relax and rest in him.
18. In addition, to succeed, we should work with him – as a team – on those things that he brings to our attention which need alteration.
19. We'll enhance our success in reaching maturity if we constantly remain in rest and peace and let him make changes on the inside of us, in our spirit.

20. There are no shortcuts in the process of growth and development to mature us as it's a life-long task.
21. Maturation will speed up if we surrender to him so he can do the deprogramming and reprogramming that we require.
22. Surrender will also enhance our deconstruction, so our foundations become Kingdom foundations, as well as other appropriate foundations³.
23. Putting pressure on ourselves to mature will destroy our essential peace and rest.
24. Pressuring ourselves to mature only leads to anxiousness, striving, and performing, which are all counterproductive to his process of transformation.
25. Pressure, anxiousness, striving, and performing are all counterproductive to life in the Kingdom, so they need to be discarded.
26. Eliminating them won't be easy because we've probably been functioning with them in our lives for a long time.
27. The important thing for us is that we're listening to what he has to say to us, 24/7.
28. To hear effectively with our spirit we need to quieten ourselves so you can hear what he has to say.
29. Importantly, it's advisable not to set goals for ourselves to reach a certain level of maturity in a particular period of time. That overlooks his role in working with us.
30. The important thing is that, over time, we learn, we grow, and we change.
31. Any change needs to be changes he's made, so that maturity is closer to reach.
32. Our King gave us life and he wants us to enjoy our lives in the natural, not just our life in the Kingdom as a son.
33. He wants us to go about life and about our business with his approval.
34. He created families, work ethic, friendship, associations, and also living with other people – in other words, he approves of them all.
35. The good in humanity he placed there, so live life to the full.
36. It's critical that we remember that we're not superhuman, just human.
37. We do have greater strength, power and authority as sons, but our human form puts limits and how much we can use of those.
38. Our goal is to become like Jesus of Nazareth, our prototype,⁴ by overcoming our human limitations.
39. To succeed in becoming like he was, we just need to be, not do – be at peace and rest in him.
40. Resting is equivalent to not striving, it doesn't mean we don't work with him on our transformation.
41. In fact, if we look back now, we'll see that we've changed in many ways, and changed for the better. That's the outcome of the work that we've done together with him.
42. He does the work in us, and we assist him through our surrender to the processes and by complying with what he instructs us to do, say or go.
43. Surrender and compliance are keys to a more rapid transformation, to reach maturity quicker.
44. Above all listen to what the King has to say to us, directly to our spirit.
45. Listen to what he says, his guidance, his wisdom, and just relax.
46. We aren't to listen to whatever our soul and mind tell us, but everything we do and say should be

righteous – i.e. what’s right in his sight.

47. Our King wants us to prioritize what he’s given us in this message, and to be content in our humanity.
48. He wants us to give ourselves some latitude to make mistakes, and to go ‘round in circles, as things distract us from working on our progress in sonship.
49. Remember, he’s with us in this journey, all the way. He’s supporting us and urging us on.
50. He doesn’t want us to get disheartened when we believe we’re not maturing quick enough.
51. Instead, he wants us to prioritize working with the desire to be mature.
52. We’ll get there, step by step, over time.
