

Transition Can Define Spiritual Reality

I hadn't heard of this concept before, so hearing Father release it has caused me to share it with my readers. Here's what he said:

*“Stay connected to Me as you move from season to season. Do not forget who I am and who you are. Include Me in your process of **transition**. If you do so, your life will be more productive, and it **will define spiritual reality**.”*¹

Too often we see transition as a time of trouble because things are often ‘topsy-turvy’ for us. This uncommon arrangement of our lives causes us to become focused on the issues that arise and we lose our main focus because our priorities change.²

However, going through the transition that Father is putting us through, and doing it with him and in alignment with him has positive outcomes. The main one, of course, is we end up where he wants us. The second is that it happens quicker that way. From this message we have the third bonus, that it opens up the spirituality that he wants us to be in, which defines our new, real, spiritual standing. The alternative is one of our own making, which is not spiritual reality because it's come from our efforts.
