“While most feminist movements are commonly associated with famous names like Gloria Steinem and other feminists, the men’s rights movement is not associated with any common men’s rights activists. However, the movement today has online communities in Reddit and subreddit, and other social media platform that champions on the right of men. Men’s rights groups have grown to become some of the fastest-growing civil rights movements in the modern-day. Men’s rights movements (MRM) started in response to the second wave of feminism. By the 1980s, some men were considering the need to champion men’s rights without being socially conservative or anti-feminist. Some of the key issues that brought rise to it included child custody, child support obligations, alimony, female-on-male domestic violence, negative masculinity, and draft requirements.”
