"What I have Forgiven is Forgiven"

Father recently made this statement"

""Watch for the temptation to feel bad about things of the past. Remind yourself that you can do nothing about any of it. What I have forgiven is forgiven," says the Lord. "Do not dig up old trash that makes your feel terrible. You are My child, My chosen. Go forth in the power of My love to seek righteousness every day."" 1

On reading that, you'd think that he's referring to past sins that you've asked for forgiveness for. That's the superficial reading from a theological perspective, but it's not the whole good news about forgiveness. Here's what he also said to us this week:

'I forgive you, because you're already forgiven, any time you miss the mark of my standards.² Let that sink in. You're already forgiven. There is no fear of punishment from me. There's no fear in the Kingdom – remember? How about you put aside all your preconceived ideas, all your fears about, 'Have I measured up? Have I followed the commands? Have I stuck with the Law?" Get rid of that. Those are the things that 'tie you in knots' and don't allow you to be free to operate with me in the plans that I have in your function as a son and in the governance of the planet."³

Yes, let that sinks in.

We're already forgiven because the cross has already freed us from our sin, once and for all. It was done in the past and covers every person who's alive at this present time. There's no need to fear the consequences of our failures (AKA sins) because there's no punishment in the Kingdom. The fear of punishment for sin is taken from the Old Covenant and is used by church leaders to frighten their congregation so that remain in control.

All we need to do is acknowledge to ourselves that we've missed the mark of Father's high standard and turn to his way of living (repent). No grovelling, pleading, fear or self-loathing is involved in our response.

The ignorance of the fact that our sins have already being forgiven – even those that haven't been committed – needs to be spread far and wide so that everyone can accept it as a reality and live free from fear of punishment and the illusion of Hell⁴.
