

You Are A Vital Human Being

There's a very strong tendency for Christians to be 'hard on themselves' when they don't 'measure up' to 'God's'¹ standards. I know, I used to be like that, until I discovered through relationship with him, that he's not fazed by my failures. That's such a critical reality that all believers need to have a revelation on.

I thought I had to perform and strive to get his approval, but he pulled me up and set me free. It occurred around the year 2000 when he told me prophetically (through others) to "Stop performing", and then, to "Stop striving". He had to tell me three times for each of those areas, before I woke up to making the change he requested. My behaviours were so ingrained in me that the messages had to come from different people before I accepted that he really wanted me to stop doing what I thought he wanted from me.

That was the beginning of my release from religion and legalism. Then, through reprogramming and an intimate love relationship with him, I was able to let him completely set me free. You see, he really wants us to be free – genuinely free from everything. That's one of the main features of the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth, right now.²

Once you realise you don't have to prove yourself to him, and that his grace and love precludes having to be chastised and disciplined for our failures, we can rise up in confidence and be who we need to be in life. Here's his mind on that:

*"Continue to move forward even when there are physical and emotional barriers. Do not sit down and give up. **You are still a vital human being, and you can do far more than you think you can.** Rise up internally to find that place of strength and hope."*³

Everything we think negatively about ourselves is an antithesis (in opposition) to Father's attitude towards us. It's anti-Kingdom, anti-Gospel, and of no value to us as sons at all. We can quite easily fall into the trap of believing negative things about ourselves, and that's no good:

*"[W]hen you screw up your life and you've got bits you can't cope with, you'll flip into the fact that perhaps God can't cope with you, and it's so anti-Gospel, and it's anti-healing and it's anti-growth for the human race and this is entrenched in our culture. It is absolutely entrenched."*⁴

When we can't comprehend and appreciate that he's already forgiven us for every sin we might commit in life, we not only are hard on ourselves, but it can develop into self-loathing. Self-loathing can then turn into self-hatred, both of which are alien to his heart and desire for us. There's no negativity in the Kingdom, so anything negative that comes into our mind we should 'kill' immediately, because it doesn't belong.
