The reality is that Father never takes us anywhere, or has us do anything, that he hasn't prepared us the handle. Now, that might be news to you, but that's how he operates lovingly as he trains us to become the person he wants us to become.

Here's his statement on that:

"When you lose hope or do not know how to proceed, quiet your soul and come into a place of rest in Me. I will give you wisdom and the courage you need to find your way. Things may seem unfamiliar and daunting, but you have not been given anything you cannot effectively handle. Trust Me," says the Lord." 1
